- 6) SUMMER DANGER: people who abuse children do NOT stop in the summer.
  - a) Talk to your children. Tell them they must tell you anytime someone says something or does something to them which makes them uncomfortable or scared. If someone says to them, "don't tell your parents", they MUST tell you!
    - b) If your child is going to visit a friend at the friend's home, check to make sure there is an adult in the house to supervise. Ask that adult if there is a computer the children use, and does the adult check on what the children are watching on the computer.
    - c) No child (under 18) should have a private password for Facebook, emails, etc. Parents must be able to access ALL communications their children receive or send to others.
